

GDPR Information Clause

The administrator of your personal data is:

CMC Poland Sp. z o.o. with its seat in Zawiercie at ul.Piłsudskiego 82.

The data administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer. In all matters related to the processing of Personal Data by the Data Controller, it is possible to obtain information by contacting the Data Protection Inspector 1) by telephone: 32 672 5101, 2) by e-mail, sending information to the address : iod.poland@cmc.com, 3) by letter and in person to the address of the seat of the Data Controller indicated above, in case of choosing personal contact after prior appointment with the Data Protection Inspector.

The Administrator processes Personal Data for the following purposes for which it indicates the following legal basis:

- a) the premise indicated in Article 61(a) of the TODO, i.e. the data subject has consented to the processing of his/her Personal Data for one or more specific purposes; on the basis of this statutory premise, Personal Data will be processed in connection with the sending of the Newsletter, the provision of the "Design a grid" module, marketing of own services, sending commercial information, organising promotional campaigns and communication, processing of data from Google Analytics, creating statistics,
- b) the premise indicated in Article 61(b) of the FAMILY, i.e. when processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party or to take action at the request of the data subject before concluding the contract. On the basis of this statutory prerequisite, personal data will be processed in connection with the conclusion, performance and settlement of the contract;
- c) the condition indicated in Article 61(c) of FAMILY, i.e. processing is necessary to fulfil the legal obligation imposed on the Administrator. This obligation arises in particular from the purposes of tax records, IT services, etc;
- d) the rationale indicated in Article 61(f) TODO, i.e. processing is necessary for the purposes of legitimate interests pursued by the controller or a third party. On the basis of this premise, Personal Data will be processed for the purpose of pursuing claims, in judicial and extra-judicial proceedings, for failure to perform or improper performance of the contract, conducting analyses of the quality of provided services in order to improve the functionality of services, ensure the safety of provided services.

Your rights are..:

- The right of access to the content of his Personal Data, i.e. the right to obtain confirmation whether the Administrator is processing the data, information concerning such processing and a copy of the data,
- The right to rectify data if the data processed by the Administrator is incorrect or incomplete,

- The right to delete or restrict the processing of Personal Data - if the processing is based on the consent granted to the Administrator,
- The right to transfer data,
- The right to object to the processing of data on the basis of the Administrator's legitimate interest,
- The right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if it is justified that your Personal Data is being processed by the Administrator in violation of the provisions of the PAC,
- Where the processing of data is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, provided that the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of your consent before it is withdrawn.

The provision of Personal Data by you is voluntary and at the same time necessary for the Administrator to fulfil the purposes of processing personal data indicated in this information.

The rights indicated above may be exercised by contacting the Administrator or the Data Protection Inspector.

Your data may be transferred to entities processing personal data on behalf of the Administrator, e.g. to external entities supporting us in providing services, e.g. IT, hosting, marketing and other entities processing data for the purpose specified by the Administrator, where such entities process data only on the basis of a contract with the Administrator.

The recipients of Personal Data are the authorized employees of the Administrator, in cases of entrusting services to other entities their authorized employees, representatives, as well as administrative bodies or institutions that request access to the data within the framework of their statutory rights.

If the data are processed on the basis of the consent given, the personal data will be processed until the data subject withdraws his or her consent. Personal data will be processed for the period provided for by law for keeping records of a given type in the case of concluding a contract, however, for a period not shorter than the statute of limitations for claims, and in the case of consent as indicated above, until its cancellation.

The relevant safeguards shall be provided through the application of standard contractual clauses pursuant to Article 46 of Regulation (EC) No 2618/2006 and Article 29(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 2409/2002 of the GDPR and Art. 28 of Directive 95/46/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 October 1995 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data (OJ L 281, 24.11.1995, p. 31) as amended.
